Crosse & Blackwell is recalling its Green Vegetable & Kale Soup because it contains milk which is not mentioned on the label. This means the product is a possible health risk for anyone with an allergy or intolerance to milk or milk constituents. The product is only sold in ASDA stores.

## Action taken by the company

Crosse & Blackwell is recalling the above product from customers and has been asked to contact the relevant allergy support organisations, which will tell their members about the recall. Point-of-sale notices will be displayed in stores selling this product. This notice explains to customers why the product is being recalled and tells them what to do if they have bought the product. ## About allergy alerts

Sometimes there will be a problem with a food product that means it should not be sold. Then it might be 'withdrawn' (taken off the shelves) or 'recalled' (when customers are asked to return the product). Sometimes foods have to be withdrawn or recalled if there is a risk to consumers because the allergy labelling is missing or incorrect or if there is any other food allergy risk. When there is a food allergy risk, the FSA will issue an Allergy Alert.
