

# Lidl GB recalls Deluxe Ecuadorian Single Origin Easter Egg because of undeclared milk

Lidl GB is recalling Deluxe Ecuadorian Single Origin Easter Egg because it may contain milk which is not mentioned on the label. This means the product is a possible health risk for anyone with an allergy or intolerance to milk or milk constituents.

## Action taken by the company

Lidl GB is recalling the above product from customers and has contacted the relevant allergy support organisations, which will tell their members about the recall. The company has also issued a point-of-sale notice to its customers. These notices explain to customers why the product is being recalled and tell them what to do if they have bought the product.
