

Sidoli recalls Gluten Free Syrup Sponge Pudding because of undeclared milk

Sidoli recalls Gluten Free Syrup Sponge Pudding because it contains milk which is not mentioned on the label. The packaging is labelled as Gluten Free Syrup Sponge Pudding, but some packs may contain Gluten Free Lemon Pudding, which contains milk. This means the product is a possible health risk for anyone with an allergy or intolerance to milk or milk constituents.

Sidoli is recalling the above product from customers and has been advised to contact the relevant allergy support organisations, which will tell their members about the recall. The company has also issued a point-of-sale notice to its customers. These notices explain to customers why the product is being recalled and tell them what to do if they have bought the product. About allergy alerts
