This means the product is a possible health risk for anyone with an allergy or intolerance to wheat or gluten, or with coeliac disease.

About allergy alerts

Sometimes there will be a problem with a food product that means it should not be sold. Then it might be 'withdrawn' (taken off the shelves) or 'recalled' (when customers are asked to return the product). When there is a food allergy risk, the FSA will issue an Allergy Alert.
