

Jalpur Millers recalls Farari Atta because of undeclared gluten

Jalpur Millers is recalling Farari Atta because it contains gluten which is not mentioned on the label. The exact cereal is currently unknown. This means the product is a possible health risk for anyone with an allergy or intolerance to gluten, or with coeliac disease.

Action taken by the company

Jalpur Millers is recalling the above product from customers and we have advised them to contact the relevant allergy organisations. The business has also issued a point-of-sale notice to its customers. These notices explain to customers why the product is being recalled and tell them what to do if they have bought the product.

Our advice to consumers

If you have bought the above product and have an allergy or intolerance to gluten, or have coeliac disease, do not eat it. Instead return it to the store from where it was bought for a full refund.

About allergy alerts

Sometimes there will be a problem with a food product that means it should not be sold. Then it might be 'withdrawn' (taken off the shelves) or 'recalled' (when customers are asked to return the product). Sometimes foods have to be withdrawn or recalled if there is a risk to consumers because the allergy labelling is missing or incorrect or if there is any other food allergy risk. When

there is a food allergy risk, the FSA will issue an Allergy Alert.
