Sainsbury's is recalling 'by Sainsbury's Coconut & Yogurt filled Breakfast Biscuits' and 'by Sainsbury's Cocoa filled Breakfast Biscuits' because they contain sesame which is not mentioned on the labels. This means the products are a possible health risk for anyone with an allergy to sesame.

Risk statement

Allergen(s): Sesame

These products contain sesame making them a possible health risk for anyone with an allergy to sesame.

Action taken by the company

Sainsbury's is recalling the above products from customers and has contacted the relevant allergy support organisations, which will tell their members about the recall. The company has also issued a point-of-sale notice to its customers. These notices explain to customers why the products are being recalled and tell them what to do if they have bought the products. Our advice to consumers

If you have bought any of the above products and have an allergy to sesame, do not eat them. Instead return the product to your nearest Sainsbury's store for a full refund.

About allergy alerts

Sometimes there will be a problem with a food product that means it should not be sold. Then it might be 'withdrawn' (taken off the shelves) or 'recalled' (when customers are asked to return the product). Sometimes foods have to be withdrawn or recalled if there is a risk to consumers because the allergy labelling is missing or incorrect or if there is any other food allergy risk. When there is a food allergy risk, the FSA will issue an Allergy Alert.
