

Co-op recalls its Hoisin Chicken Noodle Box due to undeclared milk

Co-op is recalling its Hoisin Chicken Noodle Box because it contains milk which is not mentioned on the label. This means the product is a possible health risk for anyone with an allergy or intolerance to milk or milk constituents.

These products contain milk making them a possible health risk for anyone with an allergy or intolerance to milk or milk constituents.

Action taken by the company

Co-op is recalling the above products from customers and has been asked to contact the relevant allergy support organisations, which will tell their members about the recall. The company will also display a point-of-sale notice in their stores. This notice explains to customers why the products are being recalled and tells them what to do if they have bought the products. Our advice to consumers

If you have bought the above products and have an allergy or intolerance to milk or milk constituents, do not eat them. Instead return them to the store from where they were bought for a full refund.

About allergy alerts

Sometimes there will be a problem with a food product that means it should not be sold. Then it might be 'withdrawn' (taken off the shelves) or 'recalled' (when customers are asked to return the product). Sometimes foods have to be withdrawn or recalled if there is a risk to consumers because the allergy labelling is missing or incorrect or if there is any other food allergy risk. When there is a food allergy risk, the FSA will issue an Allergy Alert.
