

Yorkshire Provender recalls Moroccan Vegetable Tagine Soup because of incorrect date labelling

Yorkshire Provender is recalling Moroccan Vegetable Tagine Soup with 'use by' date 15/10/19 due to incorrect date labelling. The product should have been labelled with a 'use by' date of 15/01/19. This means the product may be unsafe to eat if consumed after the intended 'use by' date of 15/01/19.

Risk statement

The affected product has been labelled with an incorrect 'use by' date, and it may be unsafe to eat after 15 January 2019.

Action taken by the company

Yorkshire Provender is recalling the above product. Point-of-sale notices will be displayed in all retail stores that are selling this product. These notices explain to customers why the product is being recalled and tell them what to do if they have bought the product. Please see the attached notice.

If you have bought the above product, do not eat it. Instead, return it to the store from where it was bought for a full refund.

About product recalls and withdrawals

If there is a problem with a food product that means it should not be sold, then it might be 'withdrawn' (taken off the shelves) or 'recalled' (when customers are asked to return the product). The FSA issues Product Withdrawal Information Notices and Product Recall Information Notices to let consumers and local authorities know about problems associated with food. In some cases, a 'Food Alert for Action' is issued. This provides local authorities with details of specific action to

be taken on behalf of consumers.
