itsu (grocery) is recalling its frozen itsu 4 chocolate bao'buns as some packs may contain milk which is not declared on the label. This means the product is a possible health risk for anyone with an allergy or intolerance to milk or milk constituents.

About allergy alerts

Sometimes there will be a problem with a food product that means it should not be sold.
