- retained Regulation 2023/2006 (Good Manufacturing Practice)
- retained Regulation 10/2011 (Plastics Regulation)
- retained Regulation 450/200 (on Active & Intelligent Materials)
- retained Regulation 1895/2005 (on Epoxy Derivatives)
- Council Directive 84/500/EEC (on Ceramics)
- Council Directive 78/142/EEC & Commission Directive 80/766/EEC (on Vinyl Chloride Monomer)

Purpose of the consultation

To seek stakeholders' views on the continued practicality of the Regulations, and as to whether the costs of familiarisation have markedly changed since the earlier review; whether further rationalisation would be beneficial; and as to whether enforcement could be improved.
