

# Poundstretcher recalls Nestle Dolca Chocolate Negro and Dolca Chocolate con Leche because of incorrect allergen labelling

Poundstretcher is recalling Nestle Dolca Chocolate Negro and Dolca Chocolate con Leche because they may contain nuts and milk which have been incorrectly translated on the label. This means the products are a possible health risk for anyone with an allergy to nuts and/or an allergy or intolerance to milk or milk constituents.

## Action taken by the company

Poundstretcher is recalling the above products from customers and has contacted the relevant allergy support organisations, which will tell their members about the recall. The company has also issued a point-of-sale notice to its customers. These notices explain to customers why the products are being recalled and tell them what to do if they have bought the product. ## **Our advice to consumers**

If you have bought the above products and have an allergy to nuts and/or an allergy or intolerance to milk or milk constituents, do not eat it. Instead return them to the store from where it was bought for a full refund.

### **About allergy alerts**

Sometimes there will be a problem with a food product that means it should not be sold. Then it might be 'withdrawn' (taken off the shelves) or 'recalled' (when customers are asked to return the product). Sometimes foods have to be withdrawn or recalled if there is a risk to consumers because the allergy labelling is missing or incorrect or if there is any other food allergy risk. When there is a food allergy risk, the FSA will issue an Allergy Alert.
