Milarex UK Limited is recalling Oishi-mi Sushi Salmon Teriyaki and Oishi-mi Sushi Salmon Nori with a 'Use by' date 21/06/19 due to incorrect date labelling. The products should have been labelled with a 'Use by' date of 10/06/19. This means the products may be unsafe to eat if consumed after the intended 'Use by' date of 10/06/19. The above products are only sold in some selected Aldi stores in England only.

Milarex UK Limited is recalling the above products. Point of sale notices will be displayed in all Aldi retail stores that are selling these products. These notices explain to customers why the

If you have bought the above products, do not eat them. Instead, return it to the store from where it was bought for a full refund.

About product recalls and withdrawals

If there is a problem with a food product that means it should not be sold, then it might be 'withdrawn' (taken off the shelves) or 'recalled' (when customers are asked to return the product). The FSA issues Product Withdrawal Information Notices and Product Recall Information Notices to let consumers and local authorities know about problems associated with food. In some cases, a 'Food Alert for Action' is issued. This provides local authorities with details of specific action to be taken on behalf of consumers.
