Castelli UK Ltd is recalling Le Superbe Raclette because of the possible presence of *Listeria monocytogenes*. This recall affects Tesco Stores only.

Risk statement

The possible presence of *Listeria monocytogenes* in the above product.

Symptoms caused by this organism can be similar to flu and include high temperature, muscle ache or pain, chills, feeling or being sick and diarrhoea. However, in rare cases, the infection can be more severe, causing serious complications, such as meningitis.

Some people are more vulnerable to *Listeria* infections, including those over 65 years of age, pregnant women and their unborn babies, babies less than one month old and people with weakened immune systems.

Action taken by the company

Castelli UK Ltd is recalling the above product. Point of sale notices will be displayed where the product is sold. These notices explain to customers why the product is being recalled and tell them what to do if they have bought the product. Please see the attached notice.
