

Appointments to the Food Standards Agency's Welsh Food Advisory Committee

<u>John Richards</u> and <u>Ifan Lloyd</u> have been appointed to the Committee for a three-year term commencing on 1 July 2025.

The WFAC is chaired by <u>Dr Rhian Hayward</u>, the FSA Board Member for Wales..
