Sainsbury's is recalling By Sainsbury's Slow Cooked Lamb Shoulder with Redcurrant Honey & Rosemary Glaze because it contains milk, which is not mentioned on the label. This means the product is a possible health risk for anyone with an allergy or intolerance to milk or milk constituents.

This alert was issued on 9th January 2025 and updated on 10th January 2025 with an update in the 'action taken by the company' section.
