

Farmfoods recalls Ritz Cheese Sandwich because allergens are not emphasised on the label

Farmfoods is recalling Ritz Cheese Sandwich product because it contains milk, soya and wheat (gluten), which are not emphasised on the label. This recall only affects products originating from Indonesia, and does not affect products originating from other countries.

The product contains milk, soya and wheat (gluten), making it a health risk to those with an allergy or intolerance to milk, an allergy to soya or an allergy or intolerance to wheat or gluten, or with coeliac disease.

Action taken by the company

Farmfoods is recalling the above product. Point of sale notices will be displayed in all retail stores that are selling this product, and on their website. These notices explain to customers why the product is being recalled and tell them what to do if they have bought the product. Please see the attached notice.

About allergy alerts

Sometimes there will be a problem with a food product that means it should not be sold. Then it might be 'withdrawn' (taken off the shelves) or 'recalled' (when customers are asked to return the product). Sometimes foods have to be withdrawn or recalled if there is a risk to consumers because the allergy labelling is missing or incorrect or if there is any other food allergy risk. When there is a food allergy risk, the FSA will issue an Allergy Alert.
