The European Parliament by means of the <u>Directive 2015/254</u> of 11 February 2015 repealed the <u>Council Directive 93/5/EEC</u> on assistance to the Commission and cooperation by the member states in the scientific examination of questions relating to food.

The aim of <u>Council Directive 93/5/EEC</u> was to ensure the smooth running of the Scientific Committee for Food by promoting the scientific support from the member states and by organising the cooperation with the relevant national bodies on scientific issues regarding the safety of foodstuffs.

However, the scientific tasks assigned to the Scientific Committee on Food were taken over by the Scientific Committee and Panels of the European Food Safety Authority (EFSA), following Regulation No 178/2002 of the European Parliament.
