

Unilever recalls Magnum White Chocolate ice cream tubs because of undeclared milk

Unilever UK Ltd is recalling two batches of Magnum White Chocolate ice cream tubs because they contain milk, which is not written in English on the label. This means the product is a possible health risk for anyone with an allergy or intolerance to milk or milk constituents.

Action taken by the company

Unilever UK Ltd is recalling the above product from customers and has contacted the relevant allergy support organisations, which will tell their members about the recall. The company has also issued a point-of-sale notice to its customers. These notices explain to customers why the product is being recalled and tell them what to do if they have bought the product. About allergy alerts
