Shores Seafood Pembrokeshire is recalling all cooked seafood (fresh and frozen crabs and lobsters) because the products have been produced in an establishment without the necessary approval, this means the products do not meet the food safety requirements and are therefore deemed unfit for human consumption. Live crabs and lobsters are not subject to this product recall.

Risk statement

The products listed above have been produced in an establishment without the necessary approval. This means the products do not meet the food safety requirements and are therefore deemed unfit for human consumption.

Action taken by the company

Shores Seafood Pembrokeshire is recalling the above products. Point of sale notices will be displayed in all retail stores that are selling these products. These notices explain to customers why the products are being recalled and tell them what to do if they have bought the product.

Our advice to consumers

If you have bought any of the above products do not eat them. Instead, return it to where it was bought for a full refund.

About product recalls and withdrawals

If there is a problem with a food product that means it should not be sold, then it might be 'withdrawn' (taken off the shelves) or 'recalled' (when customers are asked to return the product). The FSA issues Product Recall Information Notices to let consumers and local authorities know about problems associated with food. In some cases, a 'Food Alert for Action' is issued. This

provides local authorities with details of specific action to be taken on behalf of consumers.
