

Excessive levels of gluten in gluten free Trafo tortilla chips

FZ Organic Food BV in the Netherlands are recalling some batches of Trafo tortilla chips due to the presence of gluten. This means the products are a possible health risk for anyone with intolerance to gluten or coeliac disease. The products have been sold in the UK by Suma Wholefoods and Unicorn Grocery.

These products contain gluten making them a possible health risk for anyone with intolerance to gluten or coeliac disease.

Action taken by the company

Suma Wholefoods and Unicorn Grocery have recalled the above products from customers. The businesses have issued a point of sale notice to its customers. These notices explain to customers why the products are being recalled and tell them what to do if they have bought the

products.

Our advice to consumers

If you have bought any of the above products and have an intolerance to gluten or coeliac disease do not eat it. Instead return it to the store from where it was bought.

About allergy alerts

Sometimes there will be a problem with a food product that means it should not be sold. Then it might be 'withdrawn' (taken off the shelves) or 'recalled' (when customers are asked to return the product). Sometimes foods have to be withdrawn or recalled if there is a risk to consumers because the allergy labelling is missing or incorrect or if there is any other food allergy risk. When there is a food allergy risk, the FSA will issue an Allergy Alert.
