

# Ultralife recalls various Detox Drinks and Food Supplements due to undeclared allergens

Ultralife is recalling five varieties of their food supplement products because they contain Wheat (gluten), Milk, Nuts, Eggs and Soya that are not declared on the label. Different products contain different allergens.

A list of affected products, the undeclared allergen(s) and the possible health risk is included below.

## **Risk statement**

**Allergen(s):** Wheat (gluten), Milk, Eggs, Nuts, Soya

an allergy or intolerance to milk or milk constituents and/or

## **Action taken by the company**

Ultralife is recalling the above products from customers and has been advised to contact the relevant allergy support organisations, which will tell their members about the recall. Point-of-sale notices will be displayed on all websites and in all stores that are selling these products. These notices explain to customers why the products are being recalled and tell them what to do if they have bought the product.

## **Our advice to consumers**

If you have bought any of the above products and have an allergy or intolerance to the following then do not eat them: wheat or gluten and/or an allergy or intolerance to milk or milk constituents and/or an allergy or intolerance to eggs and/or an allergy to nuts and/or an allergy to soya. Instead return the product(s) to the store from where they were bought for a full refund.

## **About allergy alerts**

Sometimes there will be a problem with a food product that means it should not be sold. Then it might be 'withdrawn' (taken off the shelves) or 'recalled' (when customers are asked to return the product). Sometimes foods have to be withdrawn or recalled if there is a risk to consumers because the allergy labelling is missing or incorrect or if there is any other food allergy risk. When there is a food allergy risk, the FSA will issue an Allergy Alert.
