

Aunt Bessie's recalls Aunt Bessie's Croquettes because of undeclared egg

Aunt Bessie's is recalling Aunt Bessie's Croquettes because the packs may also include potato balls which contain egg which is not mentioned on the label. This means the product poses a possible health risk for anyone with an allergy or intolerance to egg. The affected product is only sold in Lidl.

Action taken by the company

Aunt Bessie's is recalling the above product from customers and has been advised to contact relevant allergy support organisations, which will tell their members about the recall. The company has also issued a point-of-sale notice to Lidl for display in stores.

Our advice to consumers

If you have bought the above product and have an allergy or intolerance to egg, do not eat it. Instead return it to the Lidl store from where it was bought.

About allergy alerts

Sometimes there will be a problem with a food product that means it should not be sold. Then it might be 'withdrawn' (taken off the shelves) or 'recalled' (when customers are asked to return the product). Sometimes foods have to be withdrawn or recalled if there is a risk to consumers because the allergy labelling is missing or incorrect or if there is any other food allergy risk. When there is a food allergy risk, the FSA will issue an Allergy Alert.
