In the original Key Findings Report: Food and You 2: Wave 8 (published on 26 September 2024), the percentage of respondents who would eat cooked meats at any point after the use-by date presented in figure 25 was incorrect.

The Key Findings report has now been updated with the correct figure. This affects the graph (figure 25) contained in the 'Use-by and best before dates' section on page 79 in which the percentage for respondents who would eat cooked meats at any point after the use-by date has been corrected from 45% to 57%. The text that supports figure 25 (found on page 80), as well as the accompanying data tables, are correct and therefore remain unchanged.
