HACCP – Food Safety Management: Your "Safer Food, Better Business" pack was checked and management checks and records are being completed.  2. Cleaning/Cleanliness: There was an accumulation of dirt and grease on the work surface along where the bare wooden board is located next to the pizza oven and an electrical socket next to the oven was dirty. next to the pizza oven cannot be cleaned/disinfected.

Other: A spot check report by Chilchester District Council (5/5/2016) first identified the bare wood board and associated accumulation of dirt and grease as a matter requiring attention. An inspection by Wendover District Council (6/4/2017) identified the same matter of the wooden board and associated poor cleaning and the inspection today has confirmed this remains a problem. In addition the WDC officer identified two other issues in his report: a wooden stick in a bucket of cut potato chips; and the food probe not being disinfected and the wipes available were not disinfectant based and past the expiry date.
