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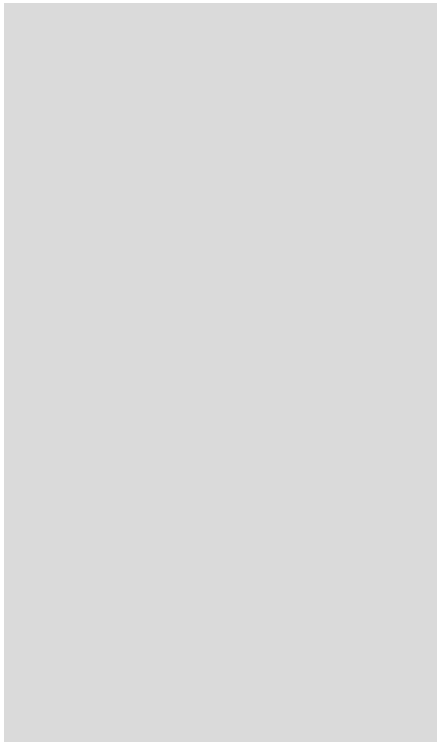

next to the pizza oven cannot be cleaned/disinfected.

*Other:* A spot check report by Chilchester District Council (5/5/2016) first identified the bare wood board and associated accumulation of dirt and grease as a matter requiring attention. An inspection by Wendover District Council (6/4/2017) identified the same matter of the wooden board and associated poor cleaning and the inspection today has confirmed this remains a problem. In addition the WDC officer identified two other issues in his report: a wooden stick in a bucket of cut potato chips; and the food probe not being disinfected and the wipes available were not disinfectant based and past the expiry date.
