1 child in every class in every school in the UK has a food allergy (up to 8% of children) ¹



Developing at any age, food allergy impacts a whole family's food choices — it's not a lifestyle choice and not food intolerance

615% increase in A&E admissions since 2005 ²




A food allergen acts like a deadly poison to someone with food allergy

The Body's Reaction

Immunoglobin E is the 'Allergy Antibody'

- IgE has been subverted to attack common proteins we don't know why.
- This change to our immune system means food allergies will continue to increase.
- A severe allergic reaction (anaphylaxis) acts like a deadly poison and kills in minutes.
- One allergic reaction doesn't predict the severity of the next.
